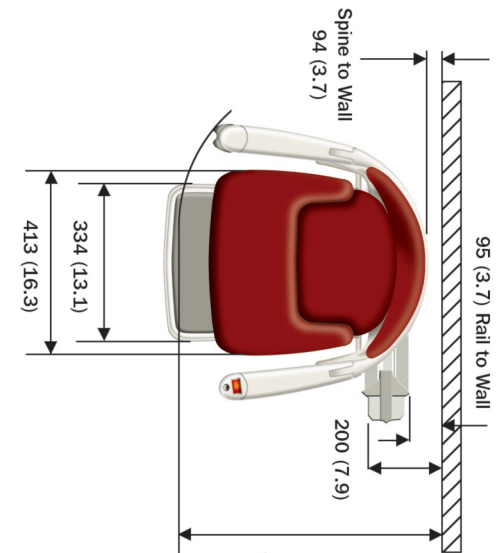
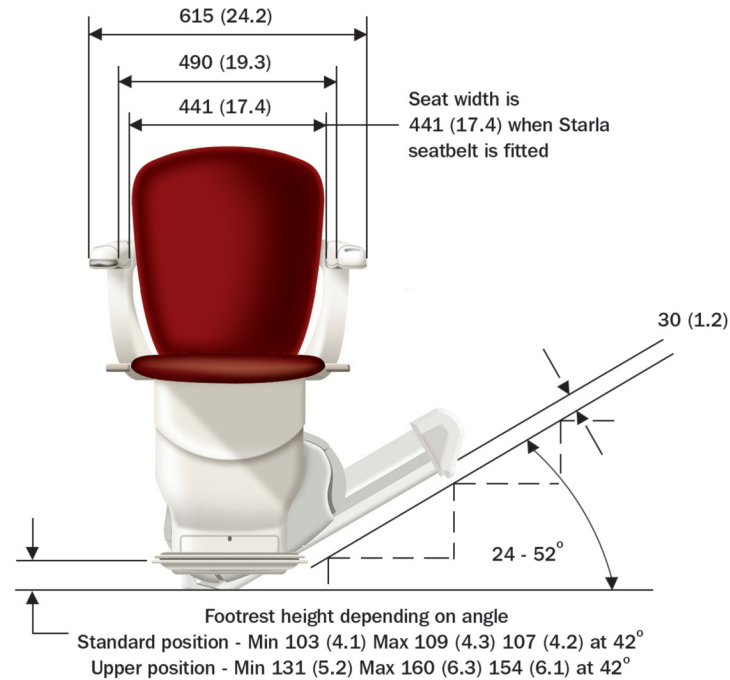
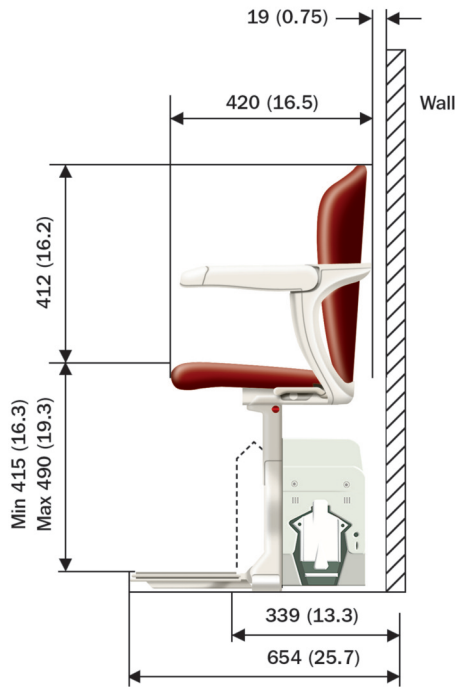

Straight Stairs Model 420: Dimensions and Technical Information

Manual swivel, one-way automatic swivel and two-way automatic swivel seat



Measurements are in millimetres. Measurements in brackets are inches. All dimensions measured from the wall are nominal. The addition of a wide stringer or similar obstruction may affect the dimensions taken from this point. Speed: 0.1 metre per second (Can vary according to user weight). The colour representation of the chair shown here is for illustrative purposes only. Weight limit note: Upto 42° - 160kg (approx 25 stone) 49° - 135kg (approx 21 stone) 49° to 52° - 120kg (approx 19 stone).

All product dimensions are accurate, however, you should add approximately 30mm on dimensions that require clearance for the user, such as the minimum swivel width dimension.
